

Copyright Policy of the Japanese Society of Toxicology

1. Copyrights for papers and articles, etc. which are published in the Journal of Toxicological Science, Fundamental Toxicological Sciences and Toxicology News issued by the Japanese Society of Toxicology (hereinafter referred to as “JSOT”) belong to the JSOT, and are subject to the protection by the Copyright Law and other various treaties, laws and regulations.
2. As for the published papers, etc., it is allowed to use and preserve in an institutional repository for the purpose of education, research and information provision, etc., to the extent determined by laws, and permission to reprint is not required.
3. When tables or figures in the published papers are disseminated or used for the purpose of education, research and information provision, etc., to the extent determined by laws, it is required to clearly state the name of journal in which the concerned paper, etc. has been published, as well as the volume, the number, the pages and the year of publication. Permission to reprint is not required.
4. In cases where authors by themselves intend to disseminate the papers in the Internet or the institutional repository, it is allowed to disseminate the “post-accepted final manuscript” even before the concerned paper is published. In such a case, it is required to clearly state that the paper is “in press.” It is not allowed to disseminate any manuscripts which are not accepted.
5. When papers, in whole or in part, published in the academic journals issued by the JSOT are intended to be issued as a part of books, etc. (including digital books, etc.) or to be used in the Internet for pursuing profits, it is required to obtain the reprint permission from the Editorial Board of the JSOT. The permission is, however, not required for the reprint in the printed materials for the non-profit purpose such as a bulletin or a research achievement issued by research institutes, etc.
